MA IN EDUCATION

Each MA program allows students to take between 12-15 credits in elective courses. A wide variety of electives are available, including independent studies, one-credit workshops, and thesis courses that allow students to further tailor the program to their particular interests. Students may also complete up to 3 credits from another Villanova graduate program, such as Mathematics, English, History or Theology.

CERTIFICATES

With the completion of 6 credits in specified courses, students can earn a graduate certificate in **Teacher Leadership** or **Higher Education Leadership**. These credits may also be applied towards the master's degree.

CERTIFICATE IN EDUCATION

With the completion of any 6 credits in graduate Education, students can earn a Certificate in Education, affording students maximum flexibility to craft a program that supports their interests and aspirations.

ACT 48 CREDIT DEVELOPMENT

Our convenient one-credit workshops allow you to earn Act 48 credits or work toward an MA in Education or a Certificate.

K-12 PRINCIPAL CERTIFICATE

This 6-credit program can be completed as a stand-alone PA certification or combined with our MA in Education.

Upon completion of the program and passing the required state testing, educators will be eligible to be a principal in PK-12 schools within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
